Mr Garth Hamilton MP, asked the Minister for Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Local Government, in writing, on 23 March 2023:

1. Will the Government honour the existing City Deal commitments, including the contribution valued at \$668 million for projects across South East Queensland.
2. Will the City Deal deliver \$25 million for the Toowoomba Railway Parklands project; if so, when will this funding be provided to the Toowoomba Regional Council for the project to commence.

Ms King - The answer to the honourable Member's question is as follows:

1. The Australian Government has committed to honour existing and funded City and Regional Deal commitments including a contribution valued at \$668 million for projects across south east Queensland (SEQ).
2. Through the SEQ Deal, the Australian and Queensland Governments and the Toowoomba Regional Council have committed \$25 million to explore options for the regeneration of the Toowoomba Railway Parklands Priority Development Area to increase housing availability.
